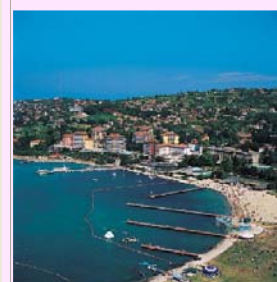
### Presentation
