The maximum length of the summary or extended abstract should be 3, A4 size pages long, including figures and diagrams. The official language of the conference will be English. Submissions will be made online at the Conference Web Site.

#### Presentation

Authors are invited to submit original papers for Conference presentations on either of the following categories: academics papers, poster presentation, research projects and industrial applications.

All accepted papers will be published in the Conference Proceedings Book and each paper will be included in the conference programme and published in the Conference Proceedings on CD-ROM.

Selected papers from IADAT-elec2010 will appear in a Issue of the IADAT Journal of Advanced Technology (ISSN 1698-1073).
