Submissions will be made online at the Conference Web Site.

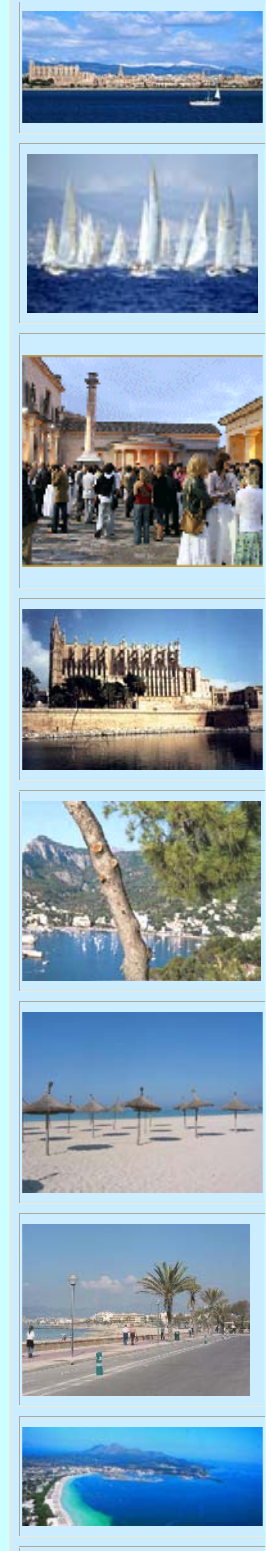
Presentation
